Trustees:

These two Charities have scant funds as the Charity's Constitution/Scheme states only interest on any capital investment can be granted to a beneficiary

Saints Yard/Town Lands:

The Constitution states funds can be used for the general benefit of inhabitants of Tivetshall St Mary e.g. taking the form of a park bench or play equipment or a donation to a village event.

Fuel Allotment:

The Constitution states that beneficiaries have to reside in Tivetshall St Mary and prove signs of hardship. Donations are made to give financial relief of a personal nature, i.e., Lifeline/donation towards funeral expenses, educational books/school uniforms etc. Up until recently the Fuel Allotment has funded three Life Lines but due to one parishioner dying and another having moved, we are now down to one.

Expenditure: £276.04 for Lifelines.

Once funds are down to the original investment sum, the Trustees will be applying to the Charity Commission to release part of that original investment and amend the rules to allow the Trustees more flexibility in giving donations.
