Tivetshall Parish Council is seeking to employ someone on a casual basis to assist the Parish Council with the basic maintenance of areas within the parishes for which it is responsible.

The post holder will be responsible for keeping the playing field and play equipment; the areas surrounding the village hall; the village green and street furniture within the villages of Tivetshall St Mary and St Margaret presentable and tidy.

The successful applicant will have the practical skills required to undertake basic maintenance and repairs of Parish Council property and equipment. Applicants must be able to work unsupervised on designated tasks, be able to demonstrate good communication skills and be willing to work outside in all weathers. Due the nature of the role the post holder will need to have the use of a car, for which mileage expenses would be paid.

As this is a new role we are appointing on a casual as and when required basis, in the first instance, to help us determine whether the role is viable. Hours of work will vary according to the needs of the Council and will be claimed and paid monthly in arrears.
